Telephone advice

Between 8.30am and 9am each day, doctors will be triaging patients and prioritising appointments. If you feel you need to speak to a doctor, you can ring at this time and a doctor will ring you back.

Nurses are available to provide telephone advice during normal surgery hours.

If a nurse cannot speak with you straight away, you can leave a message and a nurse will ring you back as soon as possible.

Repeat prescriptions

Repeat prescriptions are not routinely given at Raumati Road Surgery.

Repeat prescriptions may be available for certain regular medications when this has been previously discussed with your doctor.

If you have made prior arrangements with your doctor, repeat prescriptions may be ordered through the receptionist, nurse or Manage My Health. Please allow 72 hours for the prescription to be ready.

Blood tests and test results

Wellington SCL (located at 129a Rimu Road Paraparaumu) is open 7:30am – 4:30pm weekdays and 8am – 11:50am Saturday.

Results are usually reported within 48 hours.

You will only be contacted if there is a **significant** result. You are welcome to phone the nurses if you wish to be advised of your results.
